

# REALIBANJO INSTALLATION GUIDE

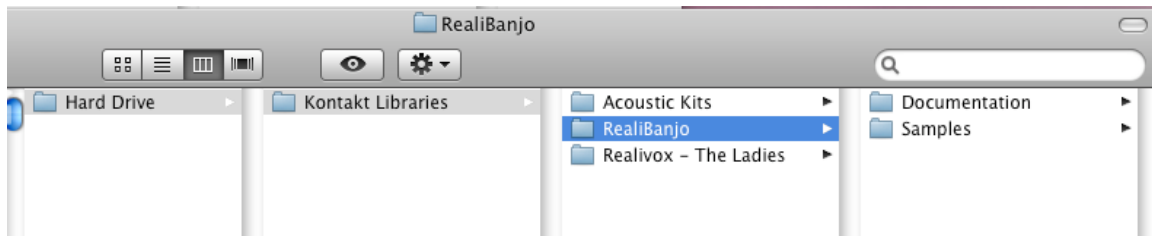

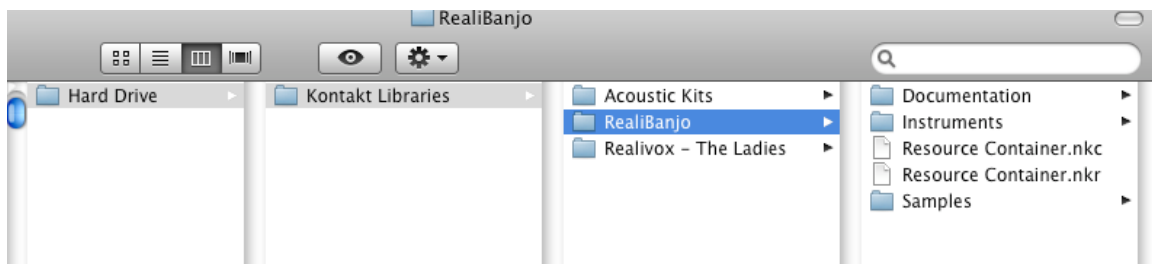
Okay, ready? Good. When you purchased RealiBanjo, you should have gotten a link to download. Download it. Then double-click it to un-zip it. You will now have a folder called "RealiBanjo."

Put that folder wherever you like to keep your Kontakt libraries. It can be anywhere – on your desktop, or in your Native Instruments folder, or on a separate hard drive. It really doesn't matter. Here's what mine looks like:



Now, you might be thinking, *"Hey Mike! I see a Documentation folder and a Samples folder inside my RealiBanjo folder . . . but where is the Instruments folder and the two Resource Container files???"*

Don't you worry! Those two folders are in a separate zip file you should have gotten in an email after you purchased RealiBanjo. Simply unzip the zip file attachment in that email, then drag the Instruments folder and the two Resource Container files into your RealiBanjo folder. So now you have this:



You're all done! Now start up Kontakt 4 or Kontakt 5, load up RealiBanjo and start pickin' and grinnin'!
